Sherborn's biggest play date

The Sherborn Community Center will kick off Friday Night at the Movies starting on Nov. 17.

More than 1,600 children have participated in the movie night sponsored by the Community Center since its inception. For a \$1 donation, the children receive popcorn, water bottles and an age-appropriate movie.

"We now have it so that the children are running Friday Night at the Movies!" said Jim Byrnes, president of the Sherborn Community Center. "They are at the door with their clipboards, assignments are given out for admissions, serving the popcorn, security, sanitation and coat check. It is quite a scene."

Friday Night at the Movies was developed in an effort by the Community Center Board to have children identify with the Community Center and simply have fun. The Community Center also sponsors a Moon Walk during the Sherborn Library Fair held in the springtime and recently held a Haunted House for the children.

For the first time in the 21-year history of the foundation, there are two student directors on the board, Alexa Collins and Kate Vacovec. They will be holding events for the middle and high school students this year. Their first event will be held on Nov. 18 with a Black and White Dance for freshmen and sophomores.
